

Addition to Doctors

In addition to a provider number, doctors are also assigned a prescriber number. Facilities can now record this information directly within the doctor's profile, eliminating the need for separate spreadsheets. This enhancement will also support future initiatives related to clinic prescribing.

Enhancement to Episode Stats Export



Addition to Certificates

A new improvement has been made regarding the addition of certificate reasons in patient records. In the **Settings** tab, you will now find an option for **Certificates**, where you can define and add your certificate reasons.





Update to Patient Alerts

FYDO has now aligned the functionality of Patient Alerts with that of Patient Allergies. When "NIL" is entered in the Patient Alerts section, it will no longer be displayed on the appointment screen, as it is deemed not applicable.



Episode Stats Date Range Addition

A new feature has been added to the **Episode Stats** section under **Reports**. When you click on the date, FYDO now provides the option to search data from specific time periods via a button. The available time periods include:

- Current Week
- Current Month
- Previous Week
- Previous Month
- Current Quarter
- Current Year
- Previous 3 Months
- Previous Quarter

This enhancement is designed to streamline your reporting process and make it easier to retrieve data for the desired time frames.



As part of the upcoming major update scheduled for **21 September 2025**, the Appointment Screen will feature a refreshed layout. A preview of the new design is shown below.





Theatre Screen Addition

FYDO has introduced a new feature within the Theatre Screen that allows users to quickly view procedure notes. As shown in the image below, a yellow “**Show Proc Notes**” icon has been added. By hovering over this icon, you can see a preview of the notes entered for the procedure.

FYDO has introduced a new tick-box option when printing lists, allowing you to generate lists exclusively for patients with **Food Instructions entered** to identify special dietary requirements. This enhancement provides a more efficient way to identify and manage patients' specific needs.



Billing Status Addition

FYDO has introduced a new ordering option within the Billing Status Report. When the **Report Type** is set to **Show Not Billed Only**, a new **Order By** field will become available. This feature functions identically to the **Order By** option in the Incomplete Report and will default to **Alphabetical** ordering.



New Option in Casebase Settings

FYDO has introduced a new column titled **Ignore Step Down** in the **Settings > Health Fund Fees > Casebase Fees** tab. This column is a tick box, similar in function to the existing **GST** column.

This enhancement addresses scenarios where certain facilities require the **Procedure Only** fee to be calculated at 100%, even when the item is listed as a secondary or subsequent procedure. However, as this rule does not apply universally to all item numbers within the Casebase list, some of which still require percentage-based step downs. The new tick box provides the flexibility to manage these exceptions on an item-by-item basis.



Exporting Fund Fees

We've made an enhancement to the **Settings > Health Fund Fees** section. The previous "Print" option, located in the top right-hand corner, has been updated and renamed to "**Export To**". This new functionality now allows you to export Health Fund Fees not only as a **PDF**, but also as an **Excel spreadsheet**, providing greater flexibility and convenience.



Bed Tracker Addition

We've introduced an additional option to the **Bed Tracker** screen for the overnight hospitals. When selecting the "**Print Handover**" button in the top right-hand corner, you will now have the ability to print the handover **by doctor**.

This enhancement ensures that doctors only view information relevant to their own patients, improving efficiency and maintaining patient confidentiality.





Merge Practices Feature

Facilities now have the ability to merge **practices**. This enhancement streamlines workflow and improves data management by providing a simple way to consolidate multiple practices and maintain a cleaner, more organized database. You will find this merge feature in **Settings > Practices > Select Practice**.

Improved workflow for creating an IFC

Wanting to generate an IFC for a patient that is NOT booked for an appointment yet? You can now

do this directly from the patient screen, eliminating the need to navigate back to the Patient List Screen. This new feature is accessible by clicking on the three dots on the right-hand side of the patient screen which will generate a drop-down menu where you will see this option.

Users will need to add additional information while using this feature, as it isn't linked to a particular episode with pre-populated item numbers etc.



Body Stats

FYDO has introduced a new **Body Stats** tab, now available within the **Clinical** section of the **Patient Screen**. This feature allows users to record a patient's height and weight, with the system automatically calculating the Body Mass Index (BMI). Users can also assign a start date to these measurements, accommodating variations across different admissions.

Additionally, user permissions for this feature can be managed within **User Groups**, with access levels configurable to **Deny**, **Read**, or **Read and Write**.



Bed Occupancy Report
