

# Data Migration Testing

When we migrate your data across from your old system into FYDO, it is important you check the data to ensure all information has come across correctly and there is no data missing.

Please ensure you follow the steps below and test your data before we move to the final migration stage. We recommend you have your old system open as well as your new FYDO account and compare all information listed below.

Please compare at least 40 patients records from a range of different dates to ensure we get a comprehensive overview of data that has been transferred.

## **Please check:**

- **10 very old patients** select patients from 5-10 years ago (*depending on how long you've used your previous system*)
- **10 patients** who have been admitted within the last 2-3 years
- **10 Patients** who have been admitted within the last 12 months
- **10 Patients** who have been admitted within the last 6 months

**When reviewing these records, please ensure the following information is accurate:**

## **Patient Screen Example:**

- Patient demographics - Patient Names, DOB, address
- Medicare Number or DVA Number
- Private Health Fund and Number
- Other Information Fields - Allergies and Notes if applicable
- Personal Information - Marital Status, Indigenous Status, Language
- Referring doctor information if applicable
- Next of Kin details if applicable
